☉ CHERUBINO AD HOC THE RIDDLER SPARKLING NV, \$21

Like all of Larry Cherubino's wines, this is terrific value and it's always good. This is a blend of reserve Pemberton chardonnay and pinot noir. It has a fragrant nose with sweet, floral aromas, a dry body and persistent finish on the palate. Very enjoyable bubbles for any family do.



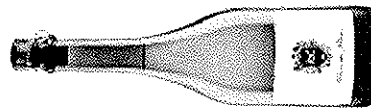
PROSECCO
☉ BABO NV PROSECCO FRIULI, \$24

Three Australian lads, who have a passion for all things Italian, made this light-bodied, dry sparkling in the northeast of Italy. It displays fresh fruit flavours and a hint of sweetness but enough acid to keep it firm and dry. It's a focused, balanced prosecco that's perfect for a balmy sunset evening.



CHAMPAGNE
☉ GOSSET GRAND BLANC DE BLANCS NV, \$125

Champagne's oldest house began production in 1584. Gosset's site in the Vallée de la Marne is home to the best red-fruit-producing slopes of the region. This newly released number is firm, with a fresh aperitif style, in the classic house tradition of no malolactic fermentation and low acidity. Balanced and elegant.



SPARKLING
☉ JED NV BLANC DE BLANC, \$23

This winery's young Aussie winemakers travelled the world looking for ideal vineyard sites and found one in Argentina, with this chardonnay and chenin blend benefiting from emerging wine region Mendoza's clean, high altitude. Minimal intervention leads to a fresh and lean wine with crisp natural acidity.
