



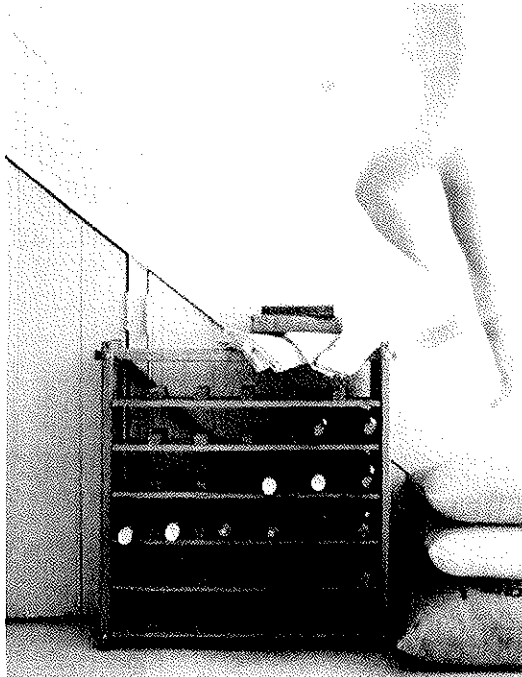
Wine for the wine lover?
