2009 WALLFLOWER RIESLING

"Riesling the shy unassuming grape"

The Vintage: 2008 was a cool dry harvest with low to moderate yields. The resulting wines have very intense flavours and soft, gentle acidity.

The Winemaking: Fruit was harvested at night and gently de-stemmed. Only the free run portion of the juice was used for this wine. Natural yeasts combined with, long cool fermentation at 10-12°C ensured that the essence of the fruit was captured.

The Wine: Soft and approachable, with citrus and floral components. Textural, gentle minerality and a long clean dry finish.
