2008 WHISPERING HILL VINEYARD RIESLING

The Vintage: Outstanding vintages with fruit achieving maximum flavours and maturity.

The Winemaking: The parcels were picked and processed within 2 hours to ensure that the vibrancy and freshness of the fruit was retained. Free run and pressing fractions were separated. All the parcels were fermented using natural yeasts only and benotage was carried out until bottling. The wine was prepared for bottling in June 2008.

The Wine: A soft and finely textured wine that may be enjoyed with food. Minerals, wet stone and lime leaf are all of the hallmarks of Mt Barker Riesling. This wine is bone dry which displays the typical structure of Riesling out of the Mount Barker region. Fruit characteristics will develop over the next 6-12 months.

Drink With: Poached fish, mildly spiced Thai dishes, Pork Belly
